Nomination of agents for *IARC Monographs*

Nominations

IARC encourages the general public, the scientific community, national health agencies, and other organizations to nominate agents for review in future *IARC Monographs*. Nominations may include chemicals, mixtures, occupations, physical agents, biological agents, lifestyle factors, and anything else suspected of causing cancer in humans. Agents will be selected for review based on: (a) evidence of human exposure; and (b) evidence or suspicion of carcinogenicity.

To nominate an agent for review, please submit a [nomination form](#) (one for each agent) and a [declaration of interests](#) for yourself.

Advisory Group

To assist IARC in selecting agents for review in future *Monographs*, IARC regularly convenes international, interdisciplinary Advisory Groups to review all public nominations and to recommend those it considers to be of high priority. IARC has convened similar Advisory Groups in 1984, 1989, 1991, 1993, 1998, 2003, 2008 and 2014. The next Advisory Group will convene from 25–27 March 2019 inclusive. In response to new scientific information or an urgent public health need, IARC may schedule nominated agents for review at any time.
